# Why Mutual Aid?

### Mutual Aid Is...

Self-determined and community guided

It is not governed by the rich, the gov, the elite, or a charismatic individual



Holistic

It is not a siloed program the excludes



#### Solidarity

Nonprofits/charities are not mutual aid: they legitimize and empower the systems of oppression

- We need these programs to survive because the systems are failing us
- 2. Participation is *generative;* this shared experience builds community and individual skills and understanding (ex: consensus, conflict resolution, etc.).
- 3. Collective care is **radical**
